

## **Electrics and Boiler Troubleshooting**

### **Electrics**

1. Is there any credit on the meter?
2. Is it just your house that is off or is the whole street cut off?
3. Have you tried resetting the fuse box/consumer unit?  
Sometimes a blown bulb will short out the whole supply.
4. Have you tried turning circuits back on individually to establish which circuit is shorting the fuse box/consumer unit?
5. Have you installed any new appliances in the house?  
The most common source of electrics tripping is the appliances.
6. What is on that circuit? Turn off all the appliances and then turn them on one by one to identify the rogue appliance.

### **Boiler**

1. Is there any credit on the gas meter?

2. Is there any credit on the electric meter?
3. Are the gas and electric supplies both turned on?
4. Is the pressure on the boiler above 1 bar?
5. Is the thermostat on? Does it have any batteries?
6. Have you tried resetting the boiler? Turning it off and back on again?
7. Turn on a hot tap then restart the boiler.
8. Check the condensate pipe has not frozen up, if it has, defrost it with some hot water.
